

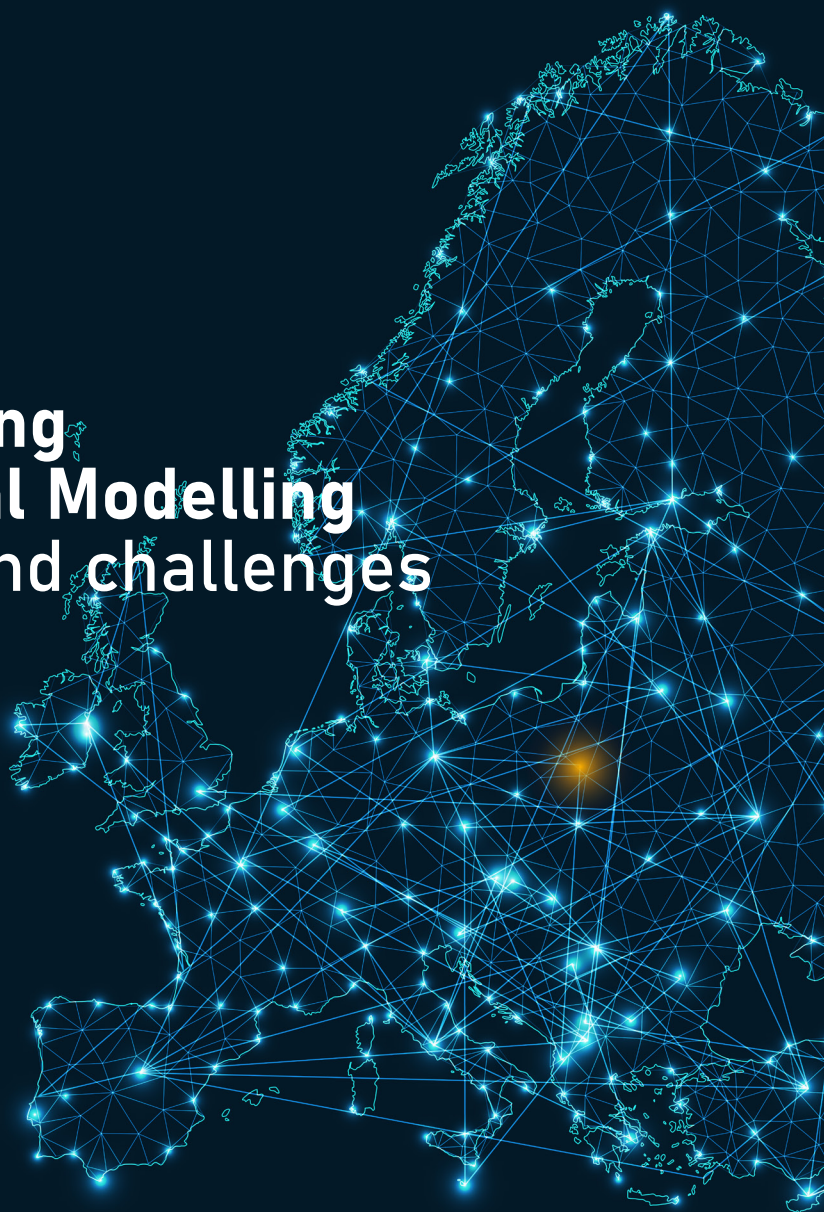

FIELD EXCURSION TO THE HOLY CROSS MOUNTAINS

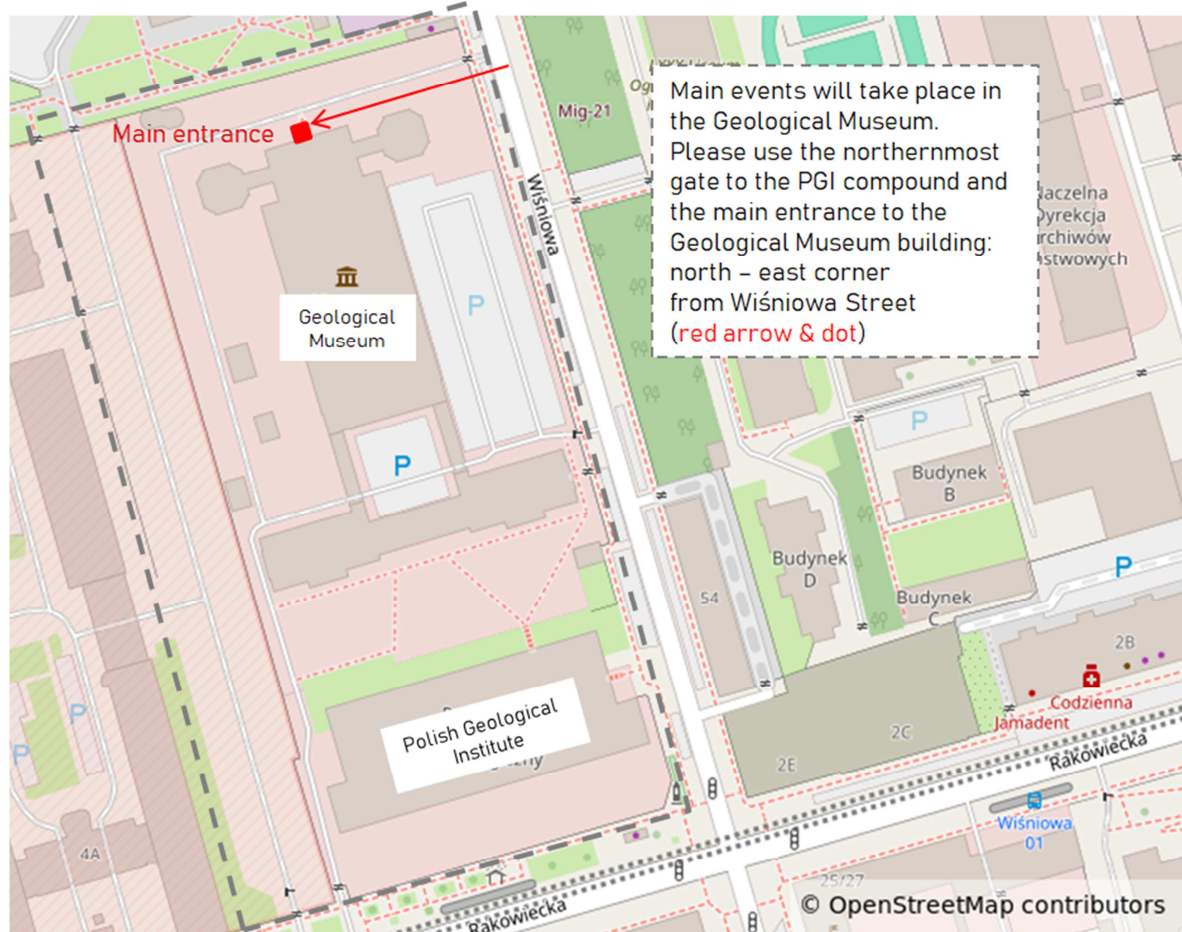
Date: **8th April 2025 (Tuesday)**

Time: **7:15 (!)** – 18:00 (ca.)

Meeting point: Main entrance to the Geological Museum (venue)

Due to roadworks, our bus will need to temporarily block traffic on Wiśniowa street to take us on. Please keep this in mind and don't be late, the bus can't wait. **We are leaving at 7:30 am sharp!**

The excursion is limited to participants with confirmed registration.



Food and drinks: a packed lunch will be provided containing a bottle of water, a juice, a fruit and 2 sandwiches. The day is long and there will be no practical option to buy extra food or drink during the trip, so please prepare accordingly.

The trip will include several outcrops, walking on occasionally steep and very muddy paths, particularly in case of recent rains. Please wear comfortable outdoor shoes and pack an impermeable.

Weather: At the beginning of April, the weather in Poland, especially in the mountains, can be very variable, with temperatures ranging from a few to as much as 20 degrees Celsius. Please keep this in mind and check the weather forecast closer to the date of the meeting.

Field trip destination is the **Holy Cross Mountains**. Lower Palaeozoic to Mesozoic sedimentary rocks starring tectonic and sedimentary structures & exceptional vertebrate trace fossils. Unique outcrops of rocks of this age in Poland. Numerous quarries and outstanding educational facilities, UNESCO geopark. and a visit to the <http://centrum-geoedukacji.pl/>. We will visit:

1. Borkowice site featuring Early Jurassic dinosaur traces.
2. Śluchowice quarry featuring Variscan deformation structures.
3. Wietrznia quarry and geoeducation centre exemplifying Devonian carbonate sedimentation.

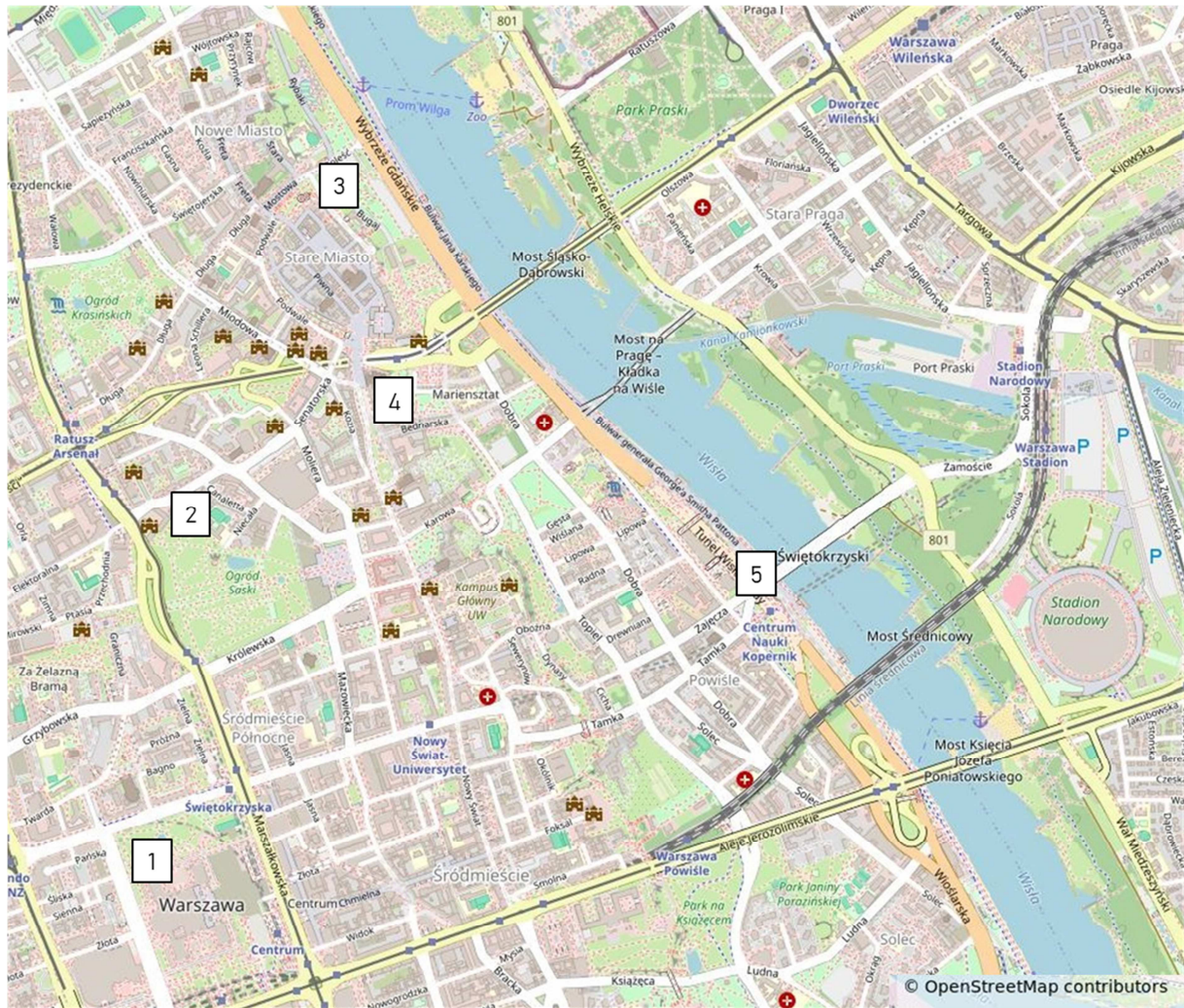

On the Wednesday afternoon we invite you to half-day city-tour through Warsaw city center. The tour is led professional guides supported by geologists who will tell you about the city's more recent and more distant history.

The duration of the walk will be around **4 hours** and the distance is ca. **5 km**. Comfortable shoes will come in handy, taking into account possible changing weather conditions. We will split into 3 groups, each with their own experienced city guide. In a case of a major downpour we will modify the plan to include some interior visits to keep the event enjoyable ☺.

The walk starts at the conference venue and will lead through Palace of Culture and Science (1 – see map below) – most spectacular example of soviet-modernist architecture in Warsaw, The Saxon Garden (2) – one of the oldest public garden in Europe, Old Town (3), Royal Route with the Royal Castle (4) – reminiscence of the gold ages and finally along the Vistula River (5) – half-wild river. The tour ends at the Elektrownia Powiśle DOCK19 restaurant, where the shared-cost dinner is planned.

We hope that it you will enjoy the tour and that it will give you a sense of the complicated history of Warsaw, which has left its indelible mark on the urban fabric.

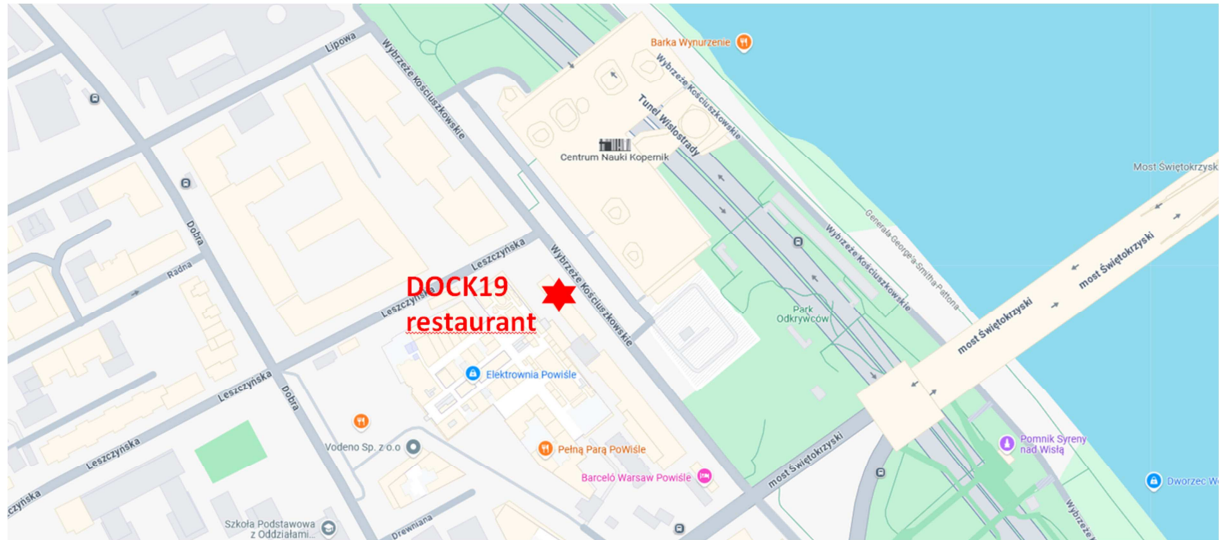

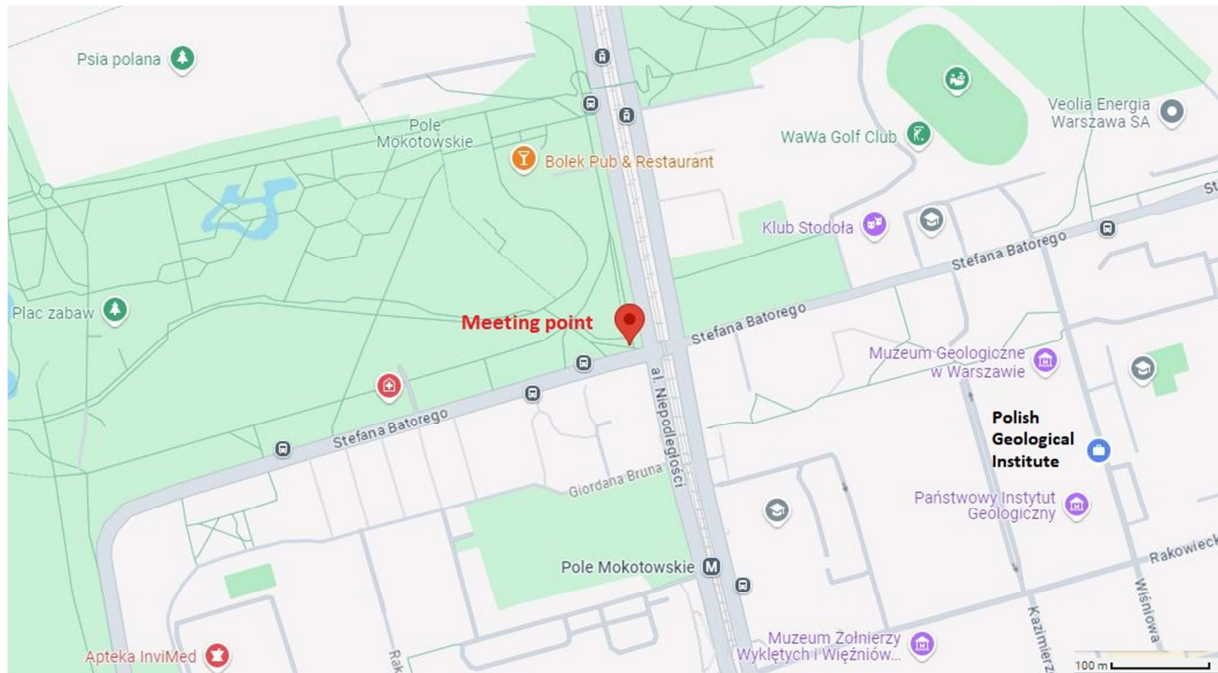
WAKE-UP WALK - BIRDWATCHING

In case of heavy rainfall, a date change is possible.

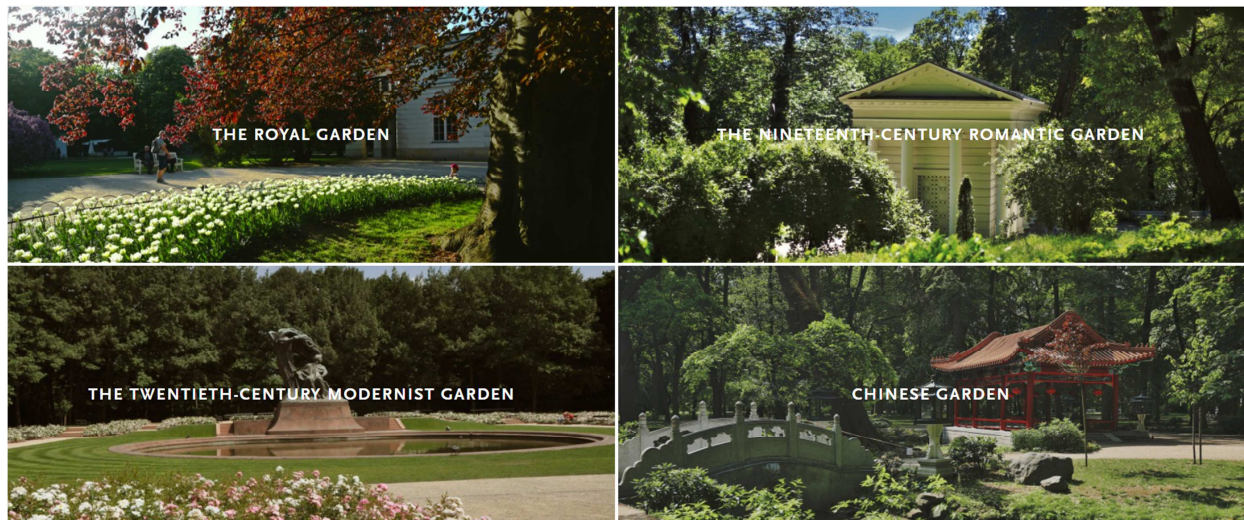
WAKE-UP RUN

in front of the main entrance of the hotel

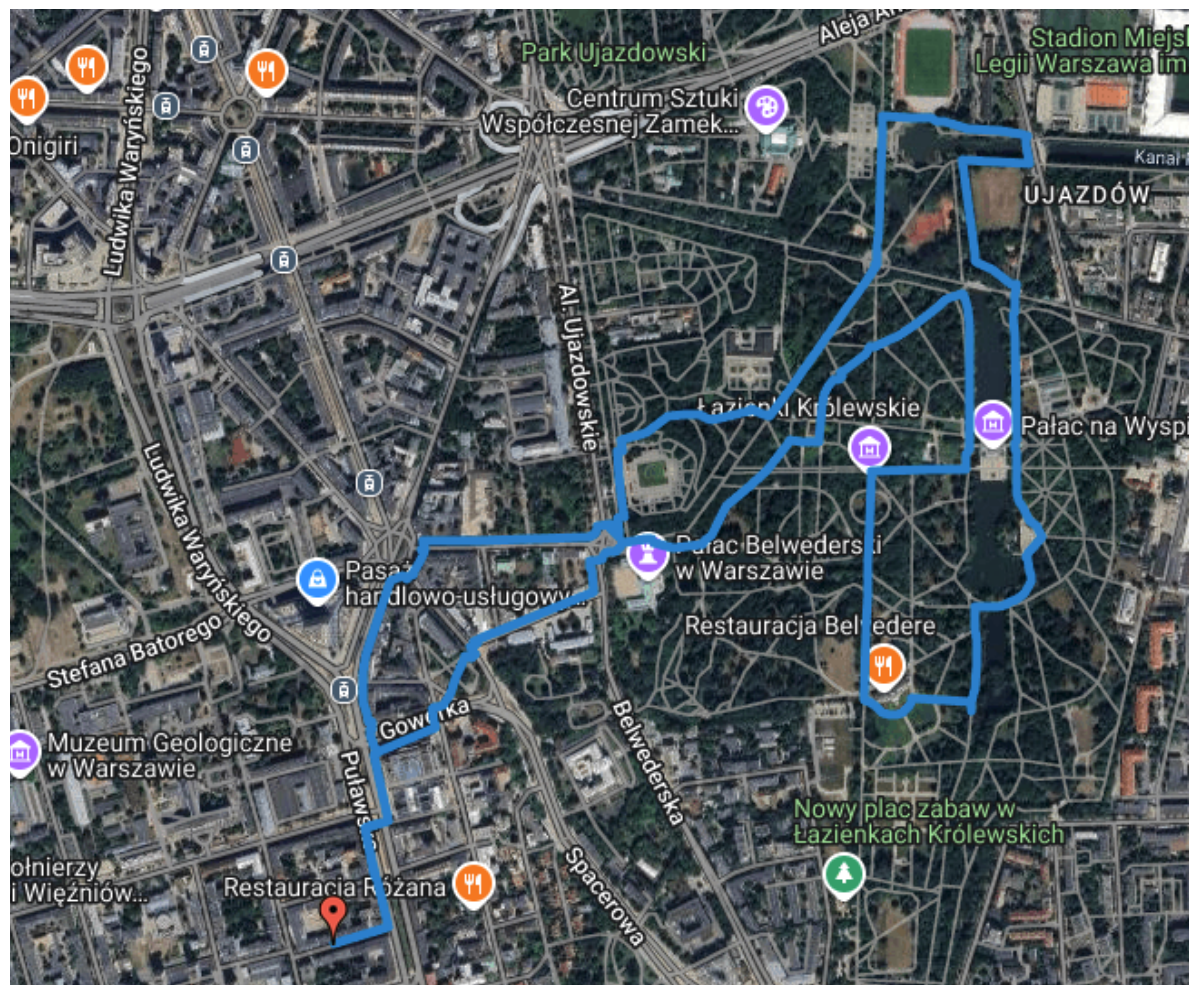
